ITINERARY

7.30am Coaches depart Kings Depot, 6 Lingard Street, Merewether. Or you may join the coach at Charlestown, Belmont North, Belmont, Swansea and Doyalson by arrangement at time of booking.

9.30am The Riverboat Postman departs from Brooklyn Wharf. See the mail, groceries, milk and odd assortment of articles taken to people who have only the river as a lifeline. Morning tea will be served upon boarding the mail boat.

Hawkesbury River Ferries have been operating charter vessels for more than 24 years and the ferry has a fully licensed bar and comfortable undercover seating. Enjoy a smorgasbord lunch while cruising.

1.30pm Rejoin the coach for return travel via the Central Coast – a stop will be made at the Sara Lee Factory Shop to Purchase “goodies”.

4.15pm Estimated time of return to King's Depot.
